- Essays must be either handwritten in black or blue ink or computer typed in Calibri script in Font size 12 on A4 size paper.
 - Firmly attach prescribed Participant Information Sheet to your essay.
- The essay must reflect your personal understanding of the topic. Plagiarism from books or internet will not be viewed favorably.
- Write on the topic given for your applicable category only.
 - Please do not make illustrations/sketches of any kind.

Prizes in each Category:

- National level :** Top three essays in each language from across the country.
Zone level : Top three essays selected in each approved language opted for in a Zone.
Institution level : Two Certificates of Merit to two top entries from each language opted for by an institution.
